



CPR for Healthcare Providers—Redmond

CPR for Healthcare Provider Course (5 hour class)

This course is designed to teach the skills of CPR for victims of all ages (including ventilation with a barrier device, a bag-mask device, and oxygen), use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) and relief of foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO) in victims of all ages. It is intended for those who work in a healthcare setting and those who are required to take a healthcare provider course for their employment.

The AHA expectation is that all healthcare providers will be proficient in bag-mask ventilation, and use of the automated external defibrillator - these skills are taught in this course.
