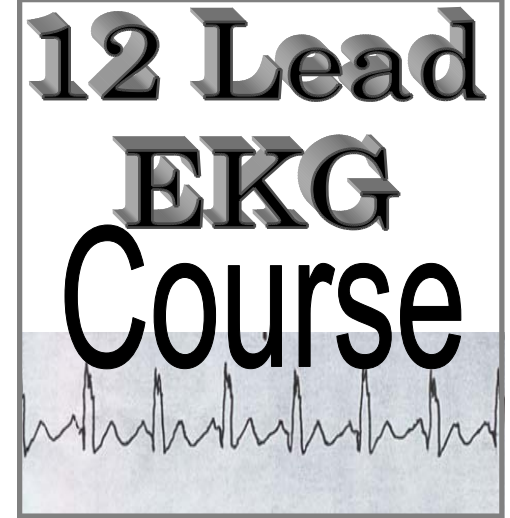

DESCRIPTION

This class is intended for nurses, techs, EMT's and paramedics who have a basic understanding of EKG's and would like to begin to dissect 12 leads. The teaching methods will include lecture, group discussion, case studies, and skill practice.

OBJECTIVES

At the completion of this class, the participant will be able to:

- Recognize and discuss normal and normal variants of 12 lead EKG's.
- Identify acute and evolving changes of myocardial infarction.
- Dissect wide complex tachycardias.
