Basic Preparation Course For Parish Nurses

The Basic Preparation Course for Parish Nurses will be offered April 24-28 at SCMC-Bend through Continuing Education of Central Oregon Community College in partnership with St. Charles Medical Center and Northwest Parish Nurse Ministries. Debbie Waring, RN, MSN, Director of Education, Northwest Parish Nurse Ministries will be the Lead Instructor.

Basic Preparation Course for Parish Nurses is a nationally endorsed curriculum from the International Parish Nurse Resource Center located in St. Louis, Missouri. The American Nurses Association recognizes parish nursing as a sub-specialty in nursing.

At the completion of the course, participants will be able to describe theoretical and practical issues essential to the understanding and development of an effective parish nurse practice, demonstrate knowledge, attitude, and skills to practice as a beginning parish nurse, embrace the integration of faith and health as central to the parish nurse role, nurture their own personal spiritual development and identify a network of continuing development and support.

The course fee is \$335, which includes materials and resources, (meals are not included). Some scholarships may be available.

Pain Management In Oregon

Inadequate pain relief is considered to be a public health problem throughout the United States. In Oregon, this has led to the passage of Senate Bill 885 in 2001 and the creation of the Oregon Pain Management Commission. The Commission is composed of healthcare providers, pain patients, and other members of the public.

The mission of the Oregon Pain Management Program is to improve access to resources and communication between Oregon healthcare providers involved in the management of pain and to raise awareness about pain management issues among healthcare providers, policy makers and the general public.

Nurses are required to have 7 hours of continuing education on Pain Management in the 2 years either before or after licensing renewal, or 2 years before or after January 2006. One hour of this education must be a course provided by the Oregon Pain Management Commission. SCMC will offer pain related learning activities in 2006. The OSBN and other hospitals around the state are sponsoring programs as well. Additionally, on-line opportunities exist.
