COCC Offers New Online Continuing Healthcare Education

The Central Oregon Community College has begun offering unique accredited certificate programs for nurses and other healthcare professionals — online.

Nine Certifications are currently available and include:

- **Complimentary and Alternative Medicine:** (28 hours) Students will enhance professional marketability by gaining a broad understanding of alternative healthcare options.
- **End of Life Care:** (26 hours) Gain useful knowledge and skills in helping dying patients through a multidisciplinary educational experience.
- **Gerontology:** (40 hours) Designed to enhance the knowledge and skills of those who work with older adults.
- **Growth and Development Through the Lifespan:** (31 hours) Students will gain insights into the peaks and valleys of human development allowing for improved relationships with colleagues and patients.
- **Oxygenation:** (32 hours) This program provides a holistic and collaborative approach to the care of patients with disorders of oxygenation.
- **Legal and Ethical Issues in Nursing:** (23 hours) Students will learn relevant and practical information that can be utilized immediately thus providing the most effective care for patients.
- **Pain Assessment and Management:** (24 hours) Examine key issues related to pain assessment and management.
- **Perinatal Issues:** (14 hours) Stay current with emerging trends in the care of childbearing women, newborns and families.
- **Spirituality, Health and Healing** (36 hours) Learn to recognize the impact spiritual values and beliefs have on health and healing.

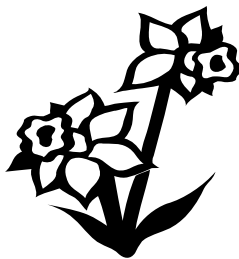

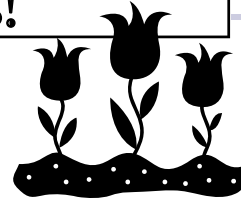
