BLS Instructor Completion 1-Day Course

Individuals certified in Healthcare Provider CPR who wish to become instructors may take this course to learn to teach all levels of Basic Life Support (CPR and First Aid) Courses. The purpose of this course is to teach interested people how to organize, teach, and document BLS classes. Participants must have good, basic BLS skills coming into the course.

Candidates must have a current HCP card and a recommendation from a current BLS Instructor. During the class participants will demonstrate a teaching session on pre-assigned topic.

Instructor candidates must be committed to teaching a minimum of 4 courses in 2 years.

****Initial competency monitoring during this class does not satisfy the required monitoring for completion of Instructor status. All candidates will be responsible to arrange their monitoring at an SCMC HCP Completion or Renewal class within 60 days of this course. Please contact the TC.*****



Instructor Course Prerequisites:

- ♥ Current Healthcare Provider certification.
- ♥ A minimum score of 90% on the written examination during Provider training without remediation.
- ♥ A written recommendation from a BLS Instructor.
- ♥ Completion of the AHA Core Instructor course by self study prior to class.

Registration should be completed at least two weeks prior to class dates. Registration cannot be confirmed until receipt of payment in full. Payment is required prior to mailing of course materials.
