Basic Life Support Instructor

BLS Instructor Completion Course

Individuals certified in Healthcare Provider CPR who wish to become instructors may take this course to learn to teach Basic Life Support Courses. The purpose of this course is to teach interested people how to organize, teach, and document BLS classes. Participants must have good BLS skills coming into the course. During the class participants will have the opportunity to practice teach with the other candidates and BLS Faculty. This course alone will not complete the certification process. You will need to be monitored teaching with in 60 days of taking this class. Upon a successful monitoring the Training Center will review the monitor form and make the decision if a card shall be issued. Instructor candidates must be committed to teaching a minimum of 4 courses in 2 years. The AHA recommends that Instructors be at least 16 years of age.

Course Prerequisites

The first three items are mandatory and need to be presented to the Training Center prior to the class date.

1. A current HCP/BLS card
2. A letter of recommendation from a current BLS Instructor, an employer or a recent teacher.
3. Completion of the AHA Core Instructor Course-upon completion a certificate may be printed
4. A strong candidate should be motivated to facilitate learning, ensure students acquire skills necessary for successful course completion and view student assessment as a way to improve individual knowledge and skills.

Registration should be completed at least two weeks prior to class dates. Registration cannot be confirmed until receipt of payment in full. Payment is required prior to mailing of course materials. Late registrations can be accepted only if space is available and prerequisites have been completed. Manuals are non refundable once distributed.
