## **The Kinsman Conference 20th Annual Bioethics Meeting “When the Bough Breaks” April 15-16, 2010 St. Charles Medical Center-Bend**



The Kinsman Conference returns on April 15-16 to SCMC-Bend. This year's conference will focus on Disaster Preparedness, Public Health, Decision Making Capacity and Reproductive Health Care Issues. The conference is brought to you by the OHSU Center for Ethics in Health Care and Cascade Healthcare Community.

The Conference is designed for ethics committee members, physicians, nurses, social workers, administrators and other health professionals. Conference faculty will explore and define today's ethical issues challenging organizations and individuals. Participants will explore four diverse crisis situations and will be able to:

- Prepare for immediate response to disasters and pandemics
- Attend to public health as an underdeveloped component of the healthcare system
- Protect the autonomy of patients by improving determination of decisional capacity
- Understand the unstable state of research data, advanced techniques and shifting laws and regulations that make reproductive decisions difficult

The Thursday Morning Session Keynote “Are you on your Own or Are We in this Together? Ethical dimensions of policy making” will be presented by Mel Kohn, MD, MPH, Director and State Health Officer, Public Health Division. This session will discuss the need for meeting ethical tensions directly when constructing healthcare policies. A Panel on Bioethical Preparedness will follow the keynote. Afternoon workshops will focus on the theme of “Public Health and Clinical Care: Two Cultures or Two Partners?”

Friday's Morning session begins with a Plenary Presentation, “Determination of Decisional Incapacity: Always Assume Capacity-Determine Incapacity” presented by Robert Potter, MD., PhD, Clinical Associate Professor, Senior Scholar, OHSU Center for Ethics in Health Care. This presentation will make the claim that respect for the autonomy of persons requires an improved process for determining decisional incapacity. A panel discussion on the same topic will follow. Afternoon workshops will focus on themes of “Decision Making Capacity” and “Reproductive Health Care Issues.”

Early bird registration deadline is March 18, 2010 and the cost is \$140. Registration after March 18 is \$170. 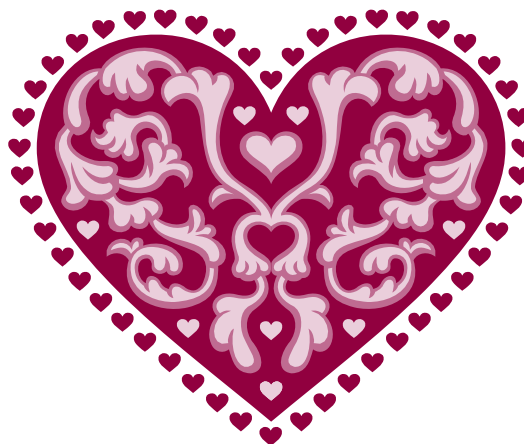
