Expansion of K-12 Health Science/Careers Programs Really Taking Off in Cascades East Region



Cascades East AHEC has been able to greatly enhance K-12 Health Science/Health Careers program offerings since hiring a staff person to coordinate and expand programs throughout the region. Some of the expanded offerings to expand the healthcare pipeline include:

Elementary/Middle School Science Education Days: We are on target to reach every county in our region during the 2008-2009 school year with hands-on science education programs that aim to keep students interested in science and promote good health habits by students. Students might learn about helmet safety, nutrition, dental health or the importance of physical activity to their health during hands-on classroom-based outreach programs held in coordination with local schools.

Great Discoveries Workshop for Teachers: This summer training program provides teacher with the tools to conduct classroom science education with students which highlights the spirit and importance of science discoveries to health and ways to engage student in learning in the classroom. Students engage in building and experimenting in ways that brings health issues 'home'.

Health Occupations Classes & Job Shadowing: Cascades East has expanded its reach to more schools and more communities serving over 200 students per year with hands-on shadowing in health care and information about pursuing health careers. We also will work with health occupations teachers and health providers to enhance programs and ensure students complete all orientation elements necessary to shadow in today's medical environment.

Youth Health Service Corp: Students can earn regional, statewide or national recognition for completing educational modules and activities and preparing community service learning or community outreach activities.

Health Care Crew Puppet Program: Students in the Youth Health Service Corp program or adult community volunteers can be trained to deliver the puppet program in K-3 classrooms. Modules teach about calling 911, health careers, dental health, safety, nutrition and preventative health behaviors.

Summer Health Career Camps: High school students can apply to participate in week-long summer programs at Eastern Oregon University, OHSU or OIT to learn more in-depth about healthcare careers and preparing for the college experience.
