Child Abuse Interviewing Trainings Spring 2005

The KIDS Center- Regional Training and Consultation Center is conducting training sessions on the *Oregon Interviewing Guidelines* (Revised 2004) throughout Central and Eastern Oregon this coming spring. These Guidelines and the subsequent training sessions are aimed at anyone who interviews children for possible abuse. The Guidelines are a recommended standard of practice used throughout the state. Their goal is to help:

- (1) elicit reliable statements about possible abuse and
- (2) maximize the amount of information provided by the child, given the child's age, circumstances and readiness to talk.

While the Guidelines are focused on child sexual abuse, the principles are applicable to conversing with children about physical abuse as well as exposure to additional risk factors, including domestic violence, neglect, exposure to alcohol and drug use or manufacture, and witnessing a crime.

The training sessions will highlight each section of the Guidelines and provide example scenarios and video clips from actual child interviews. The KIDS Center trainings are being planned and will be held in conjunction with the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Teams (MDT) of the following counties: Baker, Crook, Deschutes, Grant, Harney, Jefferson, Klamath, Lake, and Malheur.

Regional Simulation Center Coming to Central Oregon

CEAHEC has been awarded a \$50,000 grant from the Oregon Simulation Alliance to purchase advanced simulation equipment. Through the use of patient simulation more realistic scenarios can be presented to healthcare providers. Those high-risk, low frequency events can now be recreated, so staff can become familiar with treatment protocols and equipment by performing the task on a patient simulator. No more explaining what you would do in a situation, now you will perform the skill, operate the equipment, and see the responses.

Simulators can be programmed to simulate pulses, blood pressures, lung sounds, heart sounds, and bowel sounds. It even talks, through the use of preset phrases or by the instructor speaking through a microphone. You can start IV's and administer medications IV, Sub Q, or IM; intubate, defibrillate, external pacing, needle cric, chest decompression, urinary catheters and chest tubes can all be done in the training environment.

This simulation equipment will be available in the Cascades East AHEC region starting summer of 2005. CEAHEC will manage the operation of the Simulation Center and coordinate the training of operators, access and use of the equipment for any hospital, agency, or group that would like to utilize this advanced technology to enhance their training.

"This equipment can be used for trainings in hospitals, EMS agencies, fire departments, and clinics," said Leslie Terrell, Simulation Center Coordinator. According to Terrell, instructor training is need for those who would like to use the equipment, which is currently planned for Spring 2005.
