Disaster Preparedness

This has become a hot topic for all of us since 9-11. The common answer is to respond with, "It won't happen here". Maybe not, but this is an opportunity here to benefit from funding for "preparedness" coming into Oregon.

The reality that an act of terrorism is not likely in your community, but what about some other kind of disaster? Preparedness is preparedness... if you are ready for one then you are better prepared for the other. There are so many things to be ready for these days: terrorism, bioterrorism, S.A.R.S., smallpox, influenza, mad cow diseases, West Nile Virus, not to mention the normal everyday hazards in your community.

Has your hospital, community, or agency done the preparation to handle these disasters? What about helping your neighboring communities if they are impacted? Have you exercised together to discover each others strengths and weaknesses? Worked together to find out where systems mesh or don't mesh?

Through federal funding coming to communities, there will be a Regional Hospital Preparedness Board established to address community and region wide preparedness, response, communications, and more. Watch for more information in the coming months.
