On September 28-30, 2006 we invite you to join us at the 3rd Biennial Mental Health and Primary Care Conference to be held at St. Charles Medical Center – Bend. The conference will focus on practical, efficacious approaches to address the special mental health needs of our patients across the lifespan! The conference is designed to be interdisciplinary and continuing education and continuing medical education credits will be available. It has been designed by a team of regional providers to meet needs identified as prevalent in our local communities, as well as to address mental health issues we will face as healthcare providers in major disasters or pandemics. Whether you are a physician, nurse practitioner, physician's assistant, nurse, EMT, public health professional, or mental health or counseling professional, this conference is for you!

Topics will include Compassion Fatigue, Mentally Ill in Acute & Emergency Care Settings, Parent and Caregiver Strategies for Children with Mental Illness, Autistic Spectrum Disorders, Geriatric Depression, Geriatric Dementia, Mental Health Concerns for Returning Veterans, plus much more! Two panel discussions covering the Civil Commitment Process in Our Communities: Legal and Competency Issues, and a Legislative Issues Panel are part of the agenda, as well.

Conference Educational Objectives Address:

- *The continuum of care for mental illness in our communities.
- *Legal and competency issues associated with mental health conditions.
- *Mental health consequences and issues associated with health pandemics, disasters and preparedness planning.
- *The mental health needs of targeted, high-need populations, including children, adolescents, adults and seniors.
- *Improving the skills of the primary care provider to address mental health needs of children and their caregivers.
- *Improving the skills of the primary care provider to address mental health needs of seniors and their caregivers.
- *Increasing awareness of legislative and policy initiatives for improving mental health care in Oregon.

Pre-conference Workshop Session to Focus on Dealing with Disaster and Trauma in the Human Helping Professions

On September 28, 2006, Tim Dietz, EMT-P will leading a pre-conference workshop that focuses on Dealing with Disaster and Trauma in the Human Helping Professions. Included in the Crisis Incident Stress Management presentation are special segments covering:

*Disaster response and day to day stressors in the acute and emergency healthcare service/public health professions, and how these incidents may impact us. We will talk about stress recognition, prevention, and intervention as it pertains to work stress, discuss the special circumstances involved in disaster response and learn simple tools to take care of ourselves as well as our co-workers.

**"Scenes of Compassion" is an internationally recognized course revealing how responders can dramatically impact the emotions of people at emergency scenes, disasters or during pandemics. Responders learn simple tools for recognition, alleviation and recovery for both civilians and emergency workers. Topics include understanding and dealing successfully with human emotional crisis, and developing skills for scene control and mitigation.

*If any profession has an insight to how precious life is, and how quickly things can change, it is the emergency healthcare responder/public health provider. This course will provide an understanding of "Helper" stress or "the cost of caring" during and after traumatic events and disasters, and provide simple tools to achieve or continue a love for the profession and a successful, happy career.

Tim has over 23 years of fire service experience in Oregon. He is a nationally known speaker on human emotional crisis and organizational response to crisis, and is author of the book "Scenes of Compassion." He has an A.S. Degree in Fire Science, a B.S. in Human Development, a M.A in Counseling, and at present, sits on the Board of Directors for the "Oregon CISM Network."

We hope that you will be able to join us for this very special presentation. Space is limited and registrations will be taken on a priority basis for the workshop. More details will be available mid-June, however we anticipate some funding to be available to offset travel costs for participants from our region.
