Description

The class for new designated requestors is for nurses, chaplains, and social workers who wish to expand their knowledge of organ, tissue, and eye donation, and increase their skills in acting as an advocate for patients and families when presenting the option of organ and tissue donation.

This training is required for SCMC Float RNs, SCMC House Supervisors, and any caregivers who make the request for organ and tissue donation. It is strongly recommended for caregivers who work in Medical, Emergency, and Critical Care Units.

Objectives

At the completion of this training, participants will be able to:

- ✧ List community benefits of organ transplantation.
- ✧ Recognize the critical need for transplantable organs and tissue.
- ✧ Describe the process for referring potential organ and tissue donors.
- ✧ Address family concerns regarding organ and tissue donation.
- ✧ Demonstrate improved skills in acting as an advocate for patients and families.
- ✧ Meet the CMS requirement to act as designated requestors in the hospital.
- ✧ Obtain informed consent for organ and tissue donation.
- ✧ Understand and demonstrate organ donor request process, legal implications and documentation requirements.
