PALS Provider 2-Day Course

Pediatric Advanced Life Support is developed by the American Heart Association and the American Academy of Pediatrics for the continuing education of health care providers. It focuses on the identification of pre-arrest states and the prevention of cardiopulmonary arrest in children. Techniques relevant to effective pediatric resuscitation are taught. The goal of the Pediatric Advanced Life Support course is to provide the learner with: 1) information needed to recognize infants and children at risk for cardiopulmonary arrest; 2) information and strategies needed to prevent cardiopulmonary arrest in infants and children; and 3) the cognitive and psychomotor skills needed to resuscitate and stabilize infants and children in respiratory failure, shock, or cardiopulmonary arrest. Participants are required to read the text. Complete the pre-test. Demonstrate mastery of CPR skills. Course packet will be mailed to participants.

PALS Renewal 1-Day Course

The returning student will review current PALS standards and be able to demonstrate proficiency in management of the pediatric in cardiac arrest situations.

Certification is valid for two years and a renewal course is required to remain a PALS provider.

Adhering to the American Heart Association guidelines students taking a renewal course must hold a current unexpired card. A card is considered current until the last day of the month in which it expires.

The American Heart Association strongly promotes knowledge and proficiency in CPR, ACLS, and PALS and has developed instructional materials for this purpose. Use of these materials in an educational course does not represent course sponsorship by the American Heart Association, and any fees charged for such a course do not represent income to the Association.
