## OHSU Physician Consult Service

OHSU has a Physician Consult Service available as a resource for the region. A single number will connect you to a verity of services such as:

- Scheduling appointments
- Requesting medical records
- Connecting to library
- Getting information on CME

Your call will be forwarded to the most appropriate OHSU resource available to meet your needs. They promise no blind

transfers, no voice mail connection (without asking), and all calls are documented for quality control.

To access the services OHSU has to offer, call 1-800-245-6478. There are no long distance charges for the call.

OHSU asks that you give patients a different number to call for information. The patient access number is 1-888-222-6478. This number gives patients access to OHSU services.

## OHSU Psychiatric Consult Support

The Psychiatric department at OHSU has augmented their involvement in the Physician Consult Service the OHSU offers. Their goal is to make their services more accessible to primary care providers throughout the state.

They are available to assist physicians in evaluation of the likelihood of psychiatric causes for patient's symptoms. They can also help with advice concerning medication selection and dosing or other treatment strategies for mental health problems.

During weekday working hours, calls to the Consult Line will be returned by a psychiatric faculty member. They promise that the return call will usually be within minutes, but always within four hours. Urgent or emergency calls can be directed to other resources for more immediate attention.

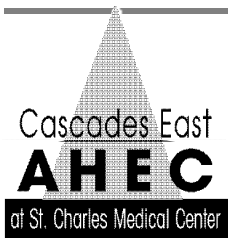
